- treat our volunteers with courtesy and respect
- let our volunteers know if you need additional assistance to understand something

## **Termination of assistance**

We reserve the right to refuse assistance or terminate our services in the following circumstances:

- if you can't abide by your obligations outlined above
- if your matter does not meet the criteria outlined in our Advice & Casework Guidelines
- where there is an irretrievable breakdown of the lawyer/client relationship
